

Protocols for if a Student is COVID-19 Positive

When a student / family is Covid-19 PCR tested positive, the student or their family should inform their school administrators. The school administrators will share this information with the Health Unit.



If a student in Early Childhood Center and in Grades 1, 2-3 is infected with Covid, their homeroom teacher (and their specialist teacher in ECC) and classmates are considered close contact and will begin online education for 10



If a covid positive student uses the school bus service, then students who sit next to, in front of and behind them are considered close contact and isolated for 10 days. They may continue their education online. Other students in the bus are considered in contact and monitored for fever and symptoms every day.



Students who have completed their quarantine process can return to school if their COVID-19 PCR test result is negative.



The Health Unit implements the close contact or contact algorithm procedures according to the "Practices to be Done in Case of Covid-19 Positive Cases in Schools" guide of the Ministry of National Education and shares it with the relevant school administrators.

If a student in Grades 4 to 12 is infected with Covid and wearing their mask at all times (it is mandatory to wear masks at school regularly, including classrooms), then, their classmates and teachers who have been in their class are considered in contact and are monitored for fever and symptoms once every two hours for 14 days.



School Administrator will prepare informative letters and announcements of COVID-19 positive information to the relevant classes.
