

NEWS FROM OUR HEALTH UNIT





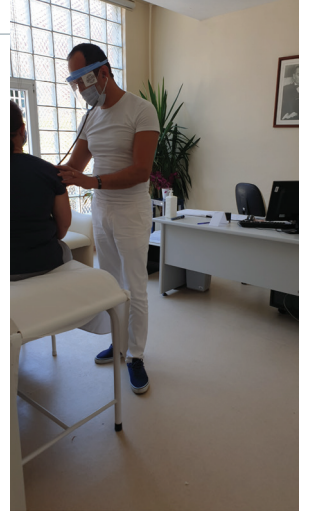
Dear Parents,

Making a difference in education with its views and experience since 1972, MEF Schools continue to make a difference by supplying the Hemogram and CRP device during the COVID-19 pandemic. This device enables our health unit to be able to view abnormalities and infections in order to protect our employees and children, who are of utmost importance to us.

The hemogram and CRP device gives us findings regarding active infections in a person in as short as 10 minutes. In this way, people who may be at risk are quickly identified and their isolation is provided as needed. Even when there are no symptoms, we would like to share with you that our health checks and tests for infection are repeated at regular intervals determined by the administration.

The health of our children and all our employees is our top priority. In this context, detailed health checks and blood tests on all of our employees (administrators, teachers, administrative staff, security guards, cooks, waiters, custodians, and school bus staff) who work at every level of our schools have been carried out under the leadership of our school doctors and nurses.





Beginning every morning from the first school day, the health status of all of our employees will be checked by an administrator or a responsible person from each unit. For those who have complaints, blood tests are further checked by a doctor's examination if necessary, and these persons are kept under observation by our administrators and health unit. In addition, within the scope of our preventive health services, all of our employees have been given training on many subjects (cleaning-disinfection, hand washing, personal hygiene, use of masks and gloves, etc.) at regular intervals in order to protect both themselves and their families.

Some training (hand washing, use of masks, personal hygiene, the nature of infection, the transmission of a virus, etc.) has been planned for our children and will be given when we start education.

We will keep you informed about further developments.
