

FACULTY DRESS CODE

STATEMENT OF AIM

MEF International Schools encourages all of its staff to dress in a way that positively reflects the school and that contributes to high standards of teaching and learning. The attire worn by school staff will project a positive reflection of the school. Clothing should be appropriate for individual responsibilities across age groups and specific subject areas.

DRESS CODE

- 1. Faculty and staff should dress in professional attire (smart casual) that reflects their respective educational roles. They should reflect a high standard of teaching and learning, and project a positive reflection of the school.
- 2. Faculty and staff must wear clean clothing and footwear that is in good repair.
- 3. Shoes must be worn at all times and should be safe for the school environment.
- 4. Clothing that is brief in size and/or exposes the midriff or chest, and/or the legs above the knee, should not be worn on campus.
- 5. Form fitting clothes, or clothing that is overly revealing should not be worn.
- 6. All science, art, or practical subject teachers are required to wear lab coats.
- 7. Hats may only be worn outside the building.
- 8. All facial hair must be tended and well groomed.
- 9. On formal occasions, such as graduation ceremonies, staff should dress in formal attire.
- 10. Faculty and staff must not wear clothing or jewellery depicting religious or political beliefs, or have words, pictures or symbols that may be deemed offensive to the school community.
